ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2009-02

**For the Purpose of Implementing the Domestic Violence Surveillance
Program (DVSP) prescribed by the Cindy Bischof Law**

WHEREAS, Public Act 095-0773 requires the use of the best available Global Positioning System (GPS) technology, including the provisions that the technology utilized should include special features, as follow:

- 1) Immediately notifies law enforcement or other monitors of any breach of the court ordered inclusion zone boundaries;
- 2) Notifies the victim in near-real time of any breach;
- 3) Allows the monitor to speak to the offender through a cell phone implanted in the bracelet device; and,
- 4) Has a loud alarm that can be activated to warn the potential victim of the offender's presence in a forbidden zone.

WHEREAS, SecureAlert's TrackerPAL II meets the capability requirements and CAM Systems is a designated service provider of the SecureAlert equipment.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that CAM Systems is authorized to provide, and/or facilitate through and with Adult Probation the initiation, hook-up, and activation of the GPS devices as delineated in the Domestic Violence Surveillance Program prescribed by the Cindy Bischof Law. Further, CAM Systems is authorized to enter into a payment contract with each individual ordered by the Court to participate in GPS monitoring.
