ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2011-02

725 ILCS 5/110-7(i) provides that, an accused (a pre or post judgment defendant) who does not appear on any date set for appearance and a (bench) warrant is issued and served, is assessed a fee of \$75 upon his admission to bail. The statute applies in cases involving the Criminal Code, Illinois Vehicle Code, Wildlife Code, Fish and Aquatic Life Code, Child Passenger Protection Act, or a comparable offense of a unit of local government.

Therefore, it is directed that all orders for bench warrants issued for such a failure to appear include the following language:

"Pursuant to the provisions of 725 ILCS 5/110-7(i), a \$75 fee is assessed upon defendant's admission to bail. Payment of the fee is not a condition of bail."
