ORDER REQUIRING CIRCUIT CLERK TO APPLY BOND
REFUNDS TO SUMS OWED BY DEFENDANT ON OTHER CASES

WHEREAS, Defendants and their assignees to whom bond refunds are payable may owe fines, fees, costs, restitution, public defender fees and other assessments in criminal and quasi-criminal cases; and

WHEREAS, The Circuit Court is permitted within its discretion, pursuant to the authority of 725 ILCS 5/110-7(f), to apply bond refunds to such other obligations of the Defendant for whom bond was posted;

NOW THEREFORE, It is hereby ordered that before refunding bond to a Defendant or Defendant's assignee in any criminal or quasi-criminal matter, the Circuit Clerk shall first apply such bond refund to fines, fees, costs, restitution, public defender fees and other assessments owed by that Defendant in other Peoria County criminal and quasi-criminal cases, unless otherwise ordered by Court;
